RE: Annual Immunization Compliance Reporting

All North Carolina public, private, and religious schools are required annually to report on the immunization status of all students in kindergarten, seventh grade, and twelfth grade (G.S. 130A-155(c)). Students attending in person, remote learning, or home-schooled are required to be compliant with regulations within 30 calendar days of the first day of attendance. Reporting is mandated within 60 calendar days after commencement of the new school year. As a result, compliance reports are due no later than **November 1, 2021**, but may be completed at any time prior to that date and are now open.
