RE: Annual Health Assessment and Immunization Compliance Reporting

All North Carolina public and public charter schools are required annually to report on the status of Health Assessments for those students who are enrolling for the first time in a North Carolina public or public charter school (§ 130A-441(c)), and the immunization status of all students in kindergarten, seventh, and twelfth grade (G.S. 130A-155(c)).
